Eligibility:

Passed/Passing Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent in any discipline with 48% marks and minimum passing marks for SC/ST/OBC-NCL in aggregate. As per University Information Bulletin.

Reservation: As per rules.

Application Form: The application form can be filled online by clicking link: <https://mlsuadmissions.sumsraj.com/main.aspx> . The application form fee is Rs.200/- to be paid online at the time of registration and form filling. The last date of filling online form is **30th May 2026**.

Admission Procedure: The merit list of admission will be prepared on the basis of merit prepared of combined score of **50% of Entrance Test Score & 50% of 12th Class Percentage**.

Admission on **80 seats from which (30 GAS + 50 SFS)** shall be made on the basis of combined score of **50% of Entrance Test & 50% of 12th Class Percentage**.

Admission procedure for Business Sponsored seats:

Admission on 10 seats of Business Sponsored shall be made through merit list prepared on the basis of XII marks & for that applications will be invited separately.

Business Sponsored Seats are exempted from Entrance Test.

Guidelines for Form Filling and Entrance Test

I. APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. The Candidate is required to fill the Application Form for BBA-ED -2026 on mlsu.ac.in and complete the registration. It is necessary to create an Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID from **Digilocker** before starting the registration.
2. During the registration, the candidate will be required to upload his/her photograph and signature.
3. After successful registration, the candidates are required to submit the requisite entrance fee
i.e Rs.200/- (Two Hundred).
4. No other mode of payment of fee shall be accepted.
5. After successful submission of fee, the online payment invoice will be generated.
6. There is no requirement to deposit the hard copy of the online application form before the date of counseling. However, the candidates need to keep a print-out of the online payment invoice and the complete application form as the same will be required at the time of counseling.

II. POINTS TO BE NOTED WITH RESPECT TO ENTRANCE TEST

1. Admission to the BBA-ED. (Three Year Course) shall be strictly on the basis of merit secured in the BBA-ED entrance test based on the 50% of marks scored and 50% of 12th class percentage within respective category which shall be published on the website as per the schedule.
2. The Entrance Test is tentatively scheduled to be held on **14th June, 2026 (Sunday) from 11:00 AM to 01:00 PM (2 Hours)**. Reporting time shall be 10:00 AM.
3. Examination Centers will be only in Udaipur. The information of Examination Center and Roll Number will be given on Admit Cards which will be made available on the website as per schedule.
4. The entrance test shall have 100 Objective Questions carrying one (1) mark each. There will be no negative marking.
5. The Candidate shall use only Blue/Black Ball point pen during the entrance examination.
6. After completion of entrance test, the candidates can carry Question Booklet with them.
7. No candidate will be permitted to enter the examination hall without the admit

card and a valid Original photo ID card (Aadhar Card/Voting ID/Driving Licence).

8. The candidates will not be allowed to enter in the Examination Hall after ten minutes of the commencement of the Examination.
9. Carrying Mobile Phone in the examination hall is strictly prohibited. If any objectionable material is found, then action will be taken under Unfair Means as per University Rules.
10. Visually impaired candidates must arrange amanuensis on their own and should carry attested copies of the certificate declaring the need for the same. Moreover attested copies of Marks Card/Certificate and Photo Identity of amanuensis who should not be qualified more than 10+2, be also submitted to the Superintendent of the Entrance Test Centre.

III. ANSWER KEY AND GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

1. The Answer Key pertaining to **BBA-ED Entrance Test -2026** shall be published on the University website as per the schedule.
2. Any objection with reference to Answer Key/Questions in the **BBA-ED Entrance Test -2026** may be submitted through mail on fms@mlsu.ac.in or in writing personally delivered to the Convener, **BBA-ED Entrance Test -2026**, Faculty of Management Studies , MLSU, Udaipur as per the schedule.
3. The grievances must include the roll number of the Candidate in the subject and any objections raised must be substantiated through the source of the objection. Grievances lacking these requirements and received beyond the scheduled time shall not be entertained.

Exam Mode: Examination will consist of multiple choice questions (Objective)
Candidates must note that the exam will be conducted in English Medium.

Duration: Exam will be conducted for duration of two hours (120 minutes)

Number of Questions: Candidates will have to attempt a total of 100 objective type questions.

Marking Scheme: Exam will carry a total of 100 marks with each question carrying 1 mark each correct answer will be given 1 mark while for incorrect answer 0 marks will be awarded.

Negative Marking: There will be no negative marking.
